"Calling Nature Home: Restoring Environmental Justice to a Wetland Habitat" Environmental Education Curriculum

LEJ's K-12 environmental education curriculum focuses on watershed studies, animals & habitats, plants, birds, water quality, marine biology, urbanization & habitat destruction, environmental justice, and environmental health. Activities match California's educational standards, including classroom and community-based activities. While the curriculum is based in the Hunters Point and Herons Head Park environments, many of the activities can be applied to any wetland area. 200 pgs. \$25 includes shipping.

"Education NOT Contamination" Environmental Justice Curriculum

This curriculum provides seven in-depth lesson plans and materials that aim to illustrate the intersections between environmental justice and environmental health, covering topics of air pollution, Bay fish contamination, chemicals and biomonitoring, pesticides, community toxics mapping, food security, and open space. 240 pp. \$30 includes shipping.
